



# HYPHAE PROGRAM

Our Kinship Team are eager to extend our environmental education efforts into our surrounding communities.



To do this we have designed a five-week initiative that sees us leading immersive environmental education sessions alongside teachers at schools in KwaMashu, Waterloo, and Inanda. There is an element of training that accompanies these sessions so that the teachers are equipped with a greater knowledge of basic Montessori philosophy, play-based and experiential learning, and feel confident to find learning experiences outside of the classroom. Our sessions explore the greater theme of earth stewardship: engaging with concepts such as water, soil, permaculture and waste management. Each session is unpacked with the teachers to develop an understanding of the importance of protecting each of these living elements, and co-create a means of doing so within their classroom environment. Teachers are offered support and inspiration as part of our Kinship Community, so that they can continue to connect with our team, each other, and join any future training events.
